Handicap Scoring System

- matches are best of 3 games up to 21
- 2 serves each
- if there is a third game, change ends when Player B reaches 10
- subtract the player handicap ratings from each other and use the difference to look up the starting scores

Examples

Handicap rating 10 plays handicap rating 60 - Player A starts on 12 : Player B starts on 0 Handicap rating 120 plays handicap rating 15 - Player A starts on 0 : Player B starts on 17 Handicap rating 25 plays handicap rating 25 - Player A starts on 0 : Player B starts on 0

Doubles

- in the Doubles match, add the handicap ratings for each team together and subtract the totals from each other and then divide by 2
- if the result is not a whole number, round it up to the next multiple of 5

Examples

Handicap ratings 40 / 55 play handicap ratings 90 / 80 - Team A starts on 12 : Team B starts on 0 (40+55=95) : (90+80=170) ~ difference = 75 / 2 = 37.5 ~ round up to next multiple of 5 = 40 Handicap ratings 10 / 115 play handicap ratings 20 / 35 - Team A starts on 0 : Team B starts on 11 (10+115=125) : (20+35=55) ~ difference = 70 / 2 = 35
