Bristol Closed Regulations

- 1. Every entrant shall have played not less than four league (either senior and/or junior matches) for their club in the current season or the immediate preceding season by the date of the close of entries. Anyone having won the same divisional singles or doubles event in the previous 2 years is ineligible to enter, however they can enter at the next level up. Participation in the Summer League (which allows non-registered players to participate) does not qualify.
- 2 TABLE TENNIS ENGLAND laws apply to this tournament, plus regulation 3 below.
- 3 Suitable footwear must be worn. The main colour of a shirt, skirt or shorts, other than the sleeves and collar of a shirt, must be clearly different from that of the ball in use.
- 4 If it is necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received/first out basis.
- Veteran events: competitors must be over 40 years of age on the closing date for entries. Over 60 and 70 event: competitors must be over birth date on the closing date for the entries.

Junior events: competitors must be:

Under 14 – on the closing date for the entries

Under 18 – on the closing date for the entries

- 6 Losing players will be required to umpire the next match. Assistant umpires will be used in the staged finals only, at the discretion of the Organising Team.
- All competitors must report to the control table on arrival. Permission to leave the hall must be obtained from a member of the organising team.
- 8 The Organising team reserve the right to alter or cancel any event.
- 9 The Championships shall be governed by the Association's Executive Committee.
