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TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

It is important that all competitors read and understand these regulations. Please take time to do this. Competitors should also ensure that they retain this sheet for reference purposes. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS (to be retained)

1. Every entrant must be affiliated to Table Tennis England as a Player Member or be a Member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament including Regulation R (Racket Re-Rubbering). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signify agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including the variations from the ITTF requirements.
4. Competitors maybe required to umpire group matches and knockout matches at the discretion of the Referee.
5. All players will be rated on the Table Tennis England Senior Rating List current at the closing date for entries. Entrants in both the men's and women's events will be banded according to this list and the groups will be played in a banded system comprising of groups of 7 or 8 players depending on the numbers of entries. All players in the group will play each other and the result will be decided by this banded system. If there are insufficient entries within any band then the Referee will adjust the bands to accommodate the players. Final positions in each group will be decided in accordance with I.T.T.F Regulation 3.7.5. All matches will be best of five games.
6. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. for Group competitions.
7. Players' clothing: main colour of clothing must be different from the colour of balls. White balls will be used in this tournament.
8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
9. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.

10. All competitors must report to the control on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
12. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
13. The referee's decision shall be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final
14. Racket testing may take place.
15. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the Table Tennis England computer ranking scheme.
16. Late entries or late payment will ONLY be accepted if there is still space in the draw and will be subject to a £2 surcharge.
17. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received at least 3 days before the event. If you have not heard anything by this time, please get in touch with the Tournament Organiser.

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Tournament Information

1. Please submit entries to: **Shawn Haskell, Tamsing, Northfield Road, Okehampton, Devon, EX20 1BB** by no later than **5th July 2018** together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
2. The draw will be held on **8th July 2018**.
3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
4. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 5 days in advance.
5. Late entries will only be accepted if there is space in the draw and will be subject to a **£2.00 surcharge**.
6. The Studio café will be open all day serving hot and cold food, drinks and snacks.
7. Changing rooms will be available at the venue, together with ample free parking.
8. Play will take place on up to 12 Joola tables with scoring machines.
9. Play will be with 3 star white Xushaofa plastic balls.
10. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height 3.2m, minimum court size 9m x 5.0m.
11. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
12. Play will be on rubberised compound sports flooring. (GERFLOR)
13. There will be no admission charge.
14. Dope and bat testing may take place.
15. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
16. Trophies will be awarded in all events.
17. The Entry Form will incorporate an undertaking as follows:-
 - To observe the regulations of the tournament.
 - To abide by the decisions of the Organising Committee.
 - To fulfil the schedule of play arranged unless prevented by circumstances beyond control and accepted
