General

Junior Singles

Entrants should be under 18 years old on 1 January 2018.

Cadets Singles

Entrants should be under 15 years old on 1 January 2018.

Veterans Singles

Entrants should be at least 40 years old on 1 January 2018.

Division 3 Singles

Open to players registered in the 2 Player Division only.

Anticipated order of play

We expect to start the event with the Handicap Singles and will then phase in other competitions.

Whenever possible we will attempt to ensure that no player faces unreasonable delays between matches.

Etiquette

Either winning or losing players may be required to umpire the next match.
