General

Restricted Singles

Players in the top 12 of the Division 1 averages will be excluded.
The committee reserves the right to vary these guidelines if appropriate.

Junior Singles

Entrants should be under 18 years old on 1 January 2019.

Cadets Singles

Entrants should be under 15 years old on 1 January 2019.

Veterans Singles

Entrants should be at least 40 years old on 1 January 2019.

Division 2 Singles

Only open to players registered in Division 2.

Division 3 Singles

Only open to players registered in Division 3 (two player division).

Anticipated Order Of Play

We expect to start the event with the Handicap Singles and will then phase in the other competitions.
Whenever possible we will attempt to ensure that no player faces unreasonable delays between matches.

Etiquette

Winning and losing players may be required to umpire the next match.
