3	Action Points & Matters Arising (not on Agenda)	Action points completed and outstanding are shown on the Action Points List.	
4	Treasurer Report	TT reported that the Club has £5688.60 in its Current Account and £48.11 in the Savings Account. He currently had £305.50 in cash to be banked in due course. TT said that attendance, and consequently income, had been excellent on Friday evenings.	
5	Membership Report	TT reported that the Club had 26 paid-up adult Members and 8 paid-up Junior Members. JW still had some completed Junior membership forms which he would pass to TT. <i>Secretary's Note: Passed to TT on 17/10/17.</i> JW reported that 5 girls had recently joined the junior section and 4 still had to pay their Membership fee. This would give a total of 12 juniors currently with another lad expected to attend on 19 th October.	
6	League Teams Update	In Division 1, Saxons were currently 2 nd , Vikings 3 rd and Crusaders 8 th . In Division 2, Normans are 4 th and Romans 5 th . In the 2-player Division Conquerors are 3 rd and Commandoes 4 th . However, it should be noted that there are very early season results.
