7	Table Tennis England Conference	 TT, TJ and JW attended this conference at Newmarket on 9th December. All three summarised the workshops they attended and the main issues for BSETTC are: To continue to submit applications to local; supermarkets token schemes. The Club is unlikely to attract sponsorship or National Lottery or other funding as it does not have its own premises. To consider attracting older members (the Committee felt that the Club already had a high proportion of older members). To consider seeking permission to put a TT table in an empty retail store (if available) to attract new members. To consider proving coaching in schools. To review current coaching methods approved by TTE. To keep eyes open for any potential new premises. TT to visit Skyliner Sports Centre. To review current TT365 website to make the best of what is currently available and check on new software from TTE i.e. Club Finder, Club Spark and other commercial software e.g. Mailchimp, Do-It. To review current vision, and strategy and update ClubMark including skills audit, role descriptions, volunteer arrangements, on-line presence, Welcome Pack.
