Regulations

1. Where appropriate for a Closed Tournament, ITTF Regulations for International Competitions 3.2 - 3.5 shall apply to this tournament. All matches will be the best of five games, and governed by the Laws of Table Tennis as adopted by TTE. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including variations from the ITTF requirements.
2. Events will commence on a group system where possible, subject to entries. Group positions will be decided by the number of matches won. If a tie occurs, games ratio, and then points ratio if necessary, will decide the positions. In both cases only matches between those concerned will be taken into account. Where groups are played, two players will progress to the knockout stage from each group. Subject to time and numbers non-qualifiers will progress to a **consolation** event.
3. All entries, which must be accompanied by the correct entry fees, should be sent to the Entries Secretary to arrive by the Closing Date.
4. If it is necessary to restrict entries, this will be done on the basis of last received, first out. Events may be cancelled or merged if there are insufficient entries.
5. In the knockout stages, each losing competitor will be required to umpire one match in each event entered.
6. No player or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
7. The Umpire's decision shall be final on points of fact, the Referee's decision final on points of law, and the Organising Committee's decision final on any other matter.
8. Players must report to the Booking-in Table on arrival, and seek the permission of the Referee to leave the premises whilst still involved in any event.
9. **To be eligible for this Closed Tournament, a player's home address must be within a 20-mile radius of Swindon Town Hall, and all players must be affiliated to Table Tennis England*. [* If not already affiliated as a Player Member, using the details provided in the Entry Form entrants will be registered via the League as Associate Members, allowing them to play competitive table tennis in this event.]**
10. Competitors must be under the respective age limits on the 31st December 2018.

Please enclose SAE if you require notification of time of first match.

Players who give an e-mail address will be notified of their start time by e-mail.

NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED ON ANY PART OF THE SITE.

No food or drink (other than your personal drinks bottle) is allowed in the Sports Hall.
