SECRETARY'S REPORT FOR SEASON 1962-63.

In spite of the arctic conditions which we had to endure during the Season, the League programme ran fairly well, the postponed matches being played off by the Annual Tournament. At least no match was postponed due to Snow on the table.

This year marked the re-entry of the League into the Harding Cup, the Surrey Inter-League Competition. Whilst not setting the Surrey T.T. world on fire, the League performed creditably in some hard fought matches to which the final statistics bear only partial witness.

The final tables showed that Lindfield had retained the Division 1 trophy by two points from Sanderstead A. In Division 2 there was a photo finish butween Beddington A. and Creeds A. The former was just successful on a games average of 168-52 against 163-57 of Creeds A. Mullards (Mitcham) who rejoined the League this Season took Division 3 by the wide margin of eleven points from Bowaters. In spite of the wide margin the competition in this division was intense; no fewer than sixteen games were drawn and forty-one ended at 6-4 out of two hundred odd games played. Hadfields B. took Division 4 after leading throughout the Season by five points from Nordent.

This year a Ladies K.O. Competition was run for the first time and eight teams took part. In the final Creeds A. beat Sanderstead 7-2. Both the Mens Senior and Junior K.O. Cup Finals were again held at the premises of Messrs. Creeds, and my thanks go to Mr. W. Smith of Creeds for his assistance in making this possible. In the Senior event Newmarks won an exciting battle with Sanderstead A. by 6-3, whilst in the Junior event Deans B. beat Mullards by the same margin.

Once again we were able to hold the Annual Tournament at Messrs. I.C.T. Ltd,'s Canteen by kind permission of the Management. Entries were up on the previous year and in a day of surprise results the Mens Singles event was won by K. Palmer whose chop defence proved too steady for A. Parker in the final. In the Mens Doubles final the holders J. Grant and R. Murray retained their title by beating C. Beauchamp and L. Gilbert. The Ladies Singles was won by Mrs. E. Iqbal who at her first appearance in the Tournament beat Mrs. R. Pope. Mrs. Iqbal teamed up with Miss G. Fielder in the Ladies Doubles to beat Mrs. E. Godfrey and Mrs. R. Pope in the final. The final event of the evening, the Junior Singles, was won by A. Buckroyd who beat A. Kita for the honours, which was again generously presented by the President.

And that just about winds it up for another Season, and it only remains for me to thank Mr. W. Smith of Creeds for duplicating the League tables throughout the Season, Mrs. W. Coles for providing soft drinks during a very hot and thirsty Tournament afternoon, and to Messrs. Bowaters for transporting tables to and from Messrs. I.G.T. Ltd.
