Regulations

1. All matches to be played in accordance with the laws of table tennis as sanctioned by the ETTA.
2. All matches will be controlled by an umpire, whose decision will be final on points of fact. The referee's decision will be final on points of law and the interpretation of these regulations.
3. The championships are open to clubs who played in the Durham County Summer League.
4. In order to maximize the number of games played the organizer will endeavor to play each event on a group basis; however will still retain the right to resort to a straight knockout if necessary.
5. Players must report to the control table on arrival and be available to play as indicated in the published draw.
6. The loser of each match must umpire the next match on that table
7. No gluing up will be allowed in the sports centre whatsoever. Contravention of this regulation may result in immediate disqualification.
8. If there are insufficient entries in either the boys or girls singles categories then they will be combined to make one mixed event.
