General

Tournament now in the winter playing season - All ages integrated into the one tournament - Everybody gets more games - Events and games at scheduled times - Ex Kentish Man/Man of Kent events now Kent Plate now open to all genders - Previous events with low numbers eliminated or combined into larger event - Mid afternoon main finals window - Guaranteed latest 6pm finish time.

Events

Play is on 12 tables match balls Xushaofa 3* white

An Open event is for all ages and genders - Events played in groups of 3/4 up to the semi final knockout stage. Kent Open Singles and Kent Open Plate Singles:

- Kent Open Singles Round 1
- group top 2 into Kent Open Singles, remaining group places into Kent Open Plate Singles Kent Open Doubles and Kent Open Plate Doubles:
- Kent Open Doubles Round 1
- group top pair into Kent Open Doubles knockout, group second into Kent Open Doubles knockout, group third eliminated

Restricted Category Singles (enter one event) - Cadet (-15) - Junior (-18) - Ladies - Senior (18-39) - Veteran 40 - Veteran 60 - group winners into the knockout semi final - Restricted Category Singles no Plate/Consolation

- In Doubles if stated as partner wanted allocations will be made with a nearest available player of like ability. All entries will be acknowledged. Should entry numbers be oversubscribed, places will be allocated in order to County team players, Kent League players, Juniors who participated in the Invicta JGP Series, players most regularly participating in our affiliated leagues.

Entry Fee

There is a single fee of £15 per player and £10 for cadets and juniors.

Entry fees must be received by the closing date.

Entry Fees are payable to the KCTTA by bank transfer or by cheque and paying details will be provided to players with their entry acknowledgement.

Acknowledged entries will be regularly posted on the Kent website.
