IOM Table Tennis League

Finalised Plan for 2018/19

Agreed by IOMTTA Committee July 2018

Introduction

- We have 33 league teams for the new season—reflecting 30 teams which finished last year + 2 additional teams from existing clubs (Peel, Travellers) + 2 new adult teams from Microgaming/Play it Forward. Meanwhile there is 1 fewer team from existing clubs as Copy Shop dropped 1 D3 team whilst Travellers E effectively transferred to Copy Shop in D4 and St Ninians have merged with Peel.
- Regional Super 6 and Grand Prix concepts being retained, however modifications being made to increase variety/standard of competition particularly for developing junior players
- Increasing match capacity by supplementing traditional Wednesday night arrangements with use of NSC Secondary Hall 7pm to 10pm Friday nights in combination with Island Squad training
- Will also use this extra midweek capacity for some of the competitions we have previously had to hold at weekends, with intention that this increases participation levels.

2018/19 Outline Plan

- Retaining existing Wednesday night NSC Secondary Hall booking from 6-30pm as at present
- Added Friday night booking from 7 to 10pm, with 6 tables used for squad training and 6 for additional match play capacity
- Wednesday will still be the main match night will schedule 11 matches on a
 Wednesday night with 6 in the first session and 5 in the later session (leaving 1 spare for flexibility)
- Will schedule 4 matches on a Friday (using 1.5 tables per match) all teams to be scheduled roughly equal share of Friday night matches over the season
- Only normally intend to have 1 league match per team each week
- Season to run broadly as recent years mid September to early May

Divisional Structure

- Have retained integrity from 2017/18's season outcome and ensured that the competition is structured optimally to benefit IOM table tennis:
- D1: retained at last year's starting level of 7 teams. Applied promotion/relegation as expected 3 rotations = 18 fixtures per team.
- D2: increased by 1 to 9 teams. Applied promotion/relegation as expected, and promoted additional Travellers team from D3 (runners-up). 2 full rotations then division will split

- into Top/Middle/Bottom 3 for 2 further matches per team to complete the programme (18 fixtures per team).
- D3: retained at 10 teams. Allowed 2 new adult teams to enter at this level and also the Travellers D team. Not promoting D4 champions Ramsey G. 2 rotations = 18 fixtures per team.
- o D4: increase by 1 to 7 teams. 3 rotations = 18 fixtures per team.

Divisional winners will be automatically promoted and bottom team automatically relegated. Runners-up will play-off against 2nd bottom team from division above for place in higher division

Other Points

- Equates to 297 league fixtures, which requires 21 week league programme. Each division has 18 matches per team
- Each week there will be a maximum of 15 fixtures generally 3 in D1, 4 in D2, 5 in D3 and 3 in D4
- Schools start back Wednesday 5th September. Matches planned to start on 19th
 September (1 week later than last year) to allow teams to be better organised and have
 more practice before season starts. NSC open nights will run on Wednesday evenings
 until then, and also including Friday 14th September
- Wednesday fixtures start at 6-30pm (6 matches predominantly from D3/4 plus occasional D2 fixtures) and 8-15pm (all 5 matches from D1/D2) as last year
- Friday matches will be spread across all divisions and start at 7-15pm. All to be completed by 10pm latest but should comfortably finish by 9-15pm
- Divisional Championships to be held during the week in November (Wednesday & Friday

 suggest 21st and 23rd) to assess whether this increases entries
- 3 Grand Prix evenings set through the season. To be held on Friday evenings of the "end of term weeks" immediately before half-term/Christmas holidays, instead of league matches and coaching that night.
- Will hold 2 Grand Prix's on each evening, on 6 tables each. The "Band 1" event will be for teams of Division 1 players only and be similar to the established arrangements. The "Band 2" event will be open to teams of players from Division 2 and below. Each Band 2

team will have to contain at least 1 Junior player. Will be both Individual and Team awards. Full details to be issued in due course.

- League season and play-offs will be completed by mid-March with play-offs to be held on Friday night of last week of league fixtures
- Plan allows 1 week of midweek matches for "Island Championship Qualifying" –
 potentially Group stages on Wednesday/Friday with knock-outs at the weekend (or
 certain elements played to a conclusion during the week). Tournament Organisers will
 determine details in due course. Currently planned for week after final league matches
 which would mean IC "finals" weekend at the end of March. Final stages could
 potentially be played the following Friday (no league matches scheduled) if desired.
- No matches programmed over Easter
- Regional Super 6 run over 2 weeks prior to Easter and the 3 weeks after. Concept will
 be broadly similar to last year. Will only need Wednesday nights for this, so the
 corresponding Friday nights will be open for Handicap Tournaments. Details to be
 determined by Tournament organiser in due course.
- Divisional winners will be automatically promoted and bottom team automatically relegated. Runners-up will play-off against 2nd bottom team from division above (17th March 2019) for place in higher division
- Prize Presentation date provisionally Friday 17th May 2019

Other Competitions

- Hard Bat & Fun Doubles half-term weeks (Wednesday only)
- Divisionals November (Wednesday & Friday)
- Top 12s suggest late January (weekend)
- Island Championships March (Wednesday & Friday plus Saturday)

Nb: Weekend events could be at Buchan or NSC

Fees for 2018/19

- Agreed Standard team fees £410, Junior teams £200 approximately 5% up on last year to reflect higher hall costs and additional playing opportunities
- Can be paid in 2 instalments as previously (September/January)
