

Applications for league places in the local Reading and Bracknell leagues are open to all full members of Kingfisher Table Tennis Club.

Now is the time to register your interest by completing and returning the attached application form. Once the cutoff date is reached the league co-ordinator will draft the teams and then a selection sub-committee will meet to review and confirm the proposed team lineup, which will then be circulated to members in early July.

Deadline for registering your interest is **Friday 24 JUNE 2016**, so don't delay, apply today.

## Eligibility

Players must be a full member of Kingfisher Table Tennis Club (Summer members will need to upgrade to full membership before their place is confirmed) and hold a player membership with Table Tennis England in order to take part in local league matches.

In the event that we are over-subscribed for team places, applications will be processed first come, first served, so please make sure that you get your application in promptly.

## Fees

League fees payable to Kingfisher will be applicable to each player for each league that they play in, regardless of how many matches they play, and is payable in advance. The league fees for 2016/17 have been set at **£20.00** per league for seniors and **£10.00** per league for juniors (The term Junior means as defined by the League/Table Tennis England and not as our Under 21 Category).

Note: fees will not be payable until the teams are drafted – do not send any money yet.

## Home Nights

The Committee have decided that all **Reading** matches should be played on Mondays, Tuesdays or Wednesdays, and **Bracknell** matches should be played on Thursdays or Fridays. 2 tables will be reserved for match play (mon-fri) and three tables available for members to practice. The Table Diary posted online and at the club will detail which tables are reserved for match play, and which are available for practice.

## Table Tennis England Subscription

League players must hold a current Player Membership subscription with Table Tennis England. This is renewable annually from 1<sup>st</sup> August.

Players are responsible for updating their player profile to indicate which leagues and clubs they are associated with – this enables the league organisers to find you on the system when the league is formed.
