Turn left at the lights (towards Heswall) at the end of the Dual Carriageway then after about 200 yards turn right into the works depot yard. (If you have turned into the Cherry Orchard Pub you have travelled too far!) Turn left at the mini roundabout and drive through the gap between the house and a pile of chippings into another yard. Parking in this area is more secure because there are both lights and CCTV security cameras. Walk back towards the mini roundabout turn left and continue beyond the barrier until you reach the pedestrian footpath. The headquarters building is on the left hand side with the front entrance facing the footpath and bowling green.

At the end of the A6027 turn left at the big roundabout (Beehive public house opposite), and continue along the A673 towards Horwich (Chorley New Road). Turn left at the traffic lights, with Aldi Supermarket on left, into Mason Street. Then take first right into Leicester Avenue and first left into Nuttall Avenue. The entrance to the Table Tennis Centre is approximately 10 metres on the right.

From East (NE or SE): Travel along M1 or A1 and onto M62. Follow M62 until junction 18 and then follow the M66 towards Blackburn and follow signs onto M65 and leave at exit 7. Then follow directions as above.

Keeping the railway line on your right hand side, Acre Bottom is at the very end of the Lane.

For Teams / players from the North / South and East of Preston.

Arrive Preston at Junction 31 M6 (Tickled Trout) or via A59 Blackburn.

Follow signs to Preston along New Hall Lane. Go to the end of New Hall Lane, T Junction, Turn Left and immediately right into Queen St.

Follow Queen St, cross Manchester Rd (mini roundabout), take the next left into St Austin's Road. The Centre is at the end of this short road. Parking is available at the front, with additional parking at the rear of the building. When entering the building the Table Tennis area is to the rear at the lower level.

For Teams arriving Preston from the West (Southport / Liverpool).

Follow the A59 into Preston (via Penwortham). Use the Guild Way flyover, into Marsh Lane, and Ring Way through the town (Bus Station on right).

Keep straight on at the next set of lights into London Rd, the Prison and Lancashire Museum will be on your left.

Go straight on (Homebase on your right), take the outside lane at the traffic lights, through the lights and turn immediately right at next lights into Queen Street.

Parking is available at the front, with additional parking at the rear of the building. When entering the building the Table Tennis area is to the rear at the lower level.

Charnock Road is the 1st right after passing over the small mini-roundabout, followed by a Pedestrian Crossing in centre of village. There is a pub called the Harrow, on the right by the Crossing. Charnock Road is approx 100 yards further on, on the right. Club is on right hand side, approx. 100 yards down Charnock Road (which is a dead-end road)

RULES of the LANCASHIRE AND CHESHIRE TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE

- 1) **NAME.** The League shall be called The Lancashire and Cheshire Table Tennis League.
- 2) **CONSTITUTION.** Membership will be open to all Leagues affiliated to either the Lancashire or the Cheshire County Associations, and such other Leagues as shall be approved by the Executive providing that those Leagues shall be affiliated to the E.T.T.A.
- 3) **SUBSCRIPTIONS.** The Annual Subscription and Registration Fee shall be determined at the Annual General Meeting. The Annual Subscription shall be paid prior to the commencement of the playing season.
- 4) **OFFICERS.** The Officers of the League shall be: President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. General Secretary and Hon. Treasurer.
- 5) **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.**
 - a) The affairs of the League shall be governed by an Executive Committee consisting of President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. General Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, and six other members, elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.
 - b) Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be authorised by the Chairman.
 - c) The Hon. Secretary shall convene all meetings of the Executive Committee and shall give fourteen days notice of each meeting.
 - d) The Chairman or, in his absence, the Vice-Chairman shall take control and his or her decisions shall be final. In the absence of both Chairman and Vice-Chairman, a member elected for the meeting shall take control and his or her decisions on all points of order shall be final. The Quorum shall be four members.
 - e) All questions shall be determined by a majority of votes of members present and voting, each member shall have one vote and in the event of an equality of votes the Chairman shall have an additional casting vote.
 - f) The Executive Committee shall have power to appoint any sub-committee for specific purposes and shall define their composition and duties.
 - g) The Executive Committee shall have power to create and fill any office and fill casual vacancies in the Official Posts as they occur, but any member or members so appointed shall hold office only until the next Annual General Meeting of the League. They shall be eligible for re-election.
 - h) The Executive Committee shall have power to co-opt for any special purpose any other representatives of the member Leagues and/or a person other than nominated representatives.

The President, Chairman, Hon. General Secretary and Hon. Treasurer shall act as an emergency committee, and any matter dealt with being reported at the next Executive meeting for confirmation.

6) **DISCIPLINARY**

- a) The Executive Committee shall have the power to deal with any breach of Rules or Regulations.
- b) A Member League, or individual registered to represent such a League, shall not do or cause to be done anything harmful to the Lancashire & Cheshire Table Tennis League, nor likely to bring the Lancashire & Cheshire Table Tennis League into disrepute.
- c) Leagues or individuals found guilty of breach of the Rules or Regulations of the Lancashire & Cheshire Table Tennis League render themselves liable to be fined, suspended, expelled and/or otherwise penalised as the Executive Committee shall decide.
- d) Any such penalty shall take immediate effect and shall commence from the moment the decision is advised either verbally, or in writing to the respective league.

7) **FINANCE.** The Hon. Treasurer shall collect all monies due to the League and shall keep a proper account of receipts and expenditure and shall submit a statement at each Executive Committee Meeting. At the discretion of the Executive Committee, he/she shall open an account with an approved Bank in the name of the League, and withdrawals shall be made on the authority of such officials as the Executive Committee shall decide. The Financial Year shall end on 30th April each year and a statement up to that date shall be prepared by the Treasurer and circulated with the notice convening the Annual General Meeting. An audited copy of the Statement shall be presented at the Annual General Meeting.

8) **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.** The Annual General Meeting shall be held in such town as may be convenient, when the Annual Report of the Executive Committee and the Financial Statement shall be presented. It shall be open to all Leagues in membership. At the Annual General Meeting, the Officers and Elected Members of the League shall have one vote. Affiliated Leagues shall have one vote for each team in membership of the Lancashire & Cheshire League for the current season. No League shall be entitled to vote at the Annual Meeting if its subscriptions or fines have not been paid. There shall be no voting by proxy. Notices convening the Annual General Meeting, stating date, time and place, shall be circulated together with a copy of the Agenda and the Financial Statement, not less than twenty-one days before the meeting, to the nominated representatives of the Member Leagues and where they are not the nominated representatives, to the General Secretaries of the Member Leagues and to all Officers and Elected Members of the Lancashire & Cheshire League. Any League not represented shall be fined £10. Leagues may only be represented by an officially registered player or an officer of that league, and only the afore mentioned shall be allowed to speak or vote. A guest speaker may be allowed to speak in an advisory capacity but not to vote. Nominations for the election of Officers and Elected Members shall be sent to the Hon. General Secretary of the League in writing not later than 1st April in each year, with the exception of the President who shall be nominated by the Executive Committee and the Vice-Presidents who shall be those duly elected by the Lancashire County and Cheshire County Associations. Two Auditors, who shall serve for two years, one retiring each year, shall be elected on the nomination of the Executive Committee. Voting at the Annual General Meeting shall be decided by a show of hands, or by a poll if a poll is demanded by two

Member Leagues, except the election of Officers and other members of the Executive Committee, when it shall be by ballot and every case where there is more than one nomination for any one office, or where more people are nominated than there are places to be filled.

9) **SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING**

- a) A Special General Meeting shall be convened on a resolution of the Committee, or within 28 days of receipt by the Hon. General Secretary of a requisition signed by 50% of the Leagues in membership, stating the business to be transacted at the meeting.
- b) Notice of meeting, right to attend, voting rights and fine for non-attendance, shall be detailed as for the Annual General Meeting.
- c) A Special General Meeting shall transact only such business as is specified in the resolution requisition convening it.

10) **ALTERATION OF RULES.** No alterations or amendments to or rescission of the rules of the League can be made except at the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting expressly called for that purpose. Any proposed alteration of, addition to or rescission of the Rules must, except in the case of a Special General Meeting, reach the Hon. General Secretary not later than the first day of April in each year; the proposals shall be circulated with the Agenda. Except in the case of a Special General Meeting, amendments to these proposals shall be accepted for consideration by the A.G.M. if submitted in writing and received by the General Secretary not later than 14 days prior to the A.G.M. Proposals for changes to Rules to be considered by a Special General Meeting shall be submitted to the Hon. General Secretary in writing, together with the requisition convening it. No alteration shall be made to the Rules unless the proposal is supported by two-thirds of the votes cast.

11) All matches shall be played in accordance with the Match Regulations which follow.

12) **OTHER MATTERS.** In the event of any question or matter arising which is not provided for in these Rules, the Executive Committee shall deal with it.

13) Any League aggrieved by a decision of the Executive Committee of the Lancashire and Cheshire Table Tennis League may appeal against such decision to a Board of Appeal which will consist of 3 persons of known impartiality, those persons being Officers of Leagues affiliated to the Lancashire and Cheshire League, but shall not be members of the Executive Committee of the Lancashire and Cheshire League. Any such appeal shall be forwarded to the General Secretary in writing not later than 10 days after receipt of notification of the decision appealed against and shall be accompanied by a deposit of £3.00 which shall be forfeited if the appeal is not upheld. All appeals shall be dealt with in accordance with the regulations for appeals as detailed in the handbook.

THE LANCASHIRE AND CHESHIRE TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE MATCH REGULATIONS

- 1) All Leagues in membership of the Lancashire and Cheshire Table Tennis Associations or Leagues as approved by the Executive Committee shall be permitted to enter one or more teams, with the following provisions:-
 - a) Applications to enter team/s in this competition must be made before 1st July.
 - b) Each League shall, by the 1st July, inform the Hon. General Secretary of the day of the week on which they wish to stage their home fixtures for each team entered.
 - c) Each League shall deposit the sum of £25.00 as a guarantee against non-fulfilment of obligations by teams entered. Such guarantee deposit shall be forfeited if any team shall not complete its fixtures in the League having been entered. The Lancashire and Cheshire Table Tennis League may deduct any fines levied against the guarantee.
 - d) Each League shall, by 31st October in each season, have paid the team fees (minimum of 3 players per team). Failure to do so will result in a fine of £10 per League per month, or part of a month, until the fees have been paid.
 - e) If any league ceases to be a member of the Lancashire and Cheshire Table Tennis League all monies held in the guarantee fund for that league shall be forfeited if not claimed within 2 years from the date of resignation.
- 2) The League shall consist of an Open Premier Division, Ladies Premier Division, Open Veterans Premier Division and Junior Premier Division. First Divisions and lower divisions shall be arranged as the Executive Committee deems necessary.
 - a) First teams shall be eligible to play in the top divisions of their respective sections. An 'A' team may also qualify to be placed in the top division of its respective section, subject to the discretion of the Executive Committee. The remaining divisions and sections shall be arranged as the Executive Committee deems necessary.
 - b) Ladies shall be allowed to play in any division or section for which they are eligible. Male Juniors and Youths shall be allowed to play in every section for which they are eligible, except the Ladies section. Males who are not eligible for Junior or Youth sections may play in the other sections for which they are eligible, but not the Ladies section.
- 3) Each League shall pay an all-in team fee which would incorporate player registrations. The fee to be determined by an Executive Committee Meeting and passed at an AGM. Each League shall register with the Hon. General Secretary sufficient players to enable it to run the number of teams entered; additional players may be registered at any time. All players shall be registered by signing a Registration Form, each player signing his/her own form and one only. Before being eligible to play, the registration form, must be received by the Hon. General Secretary, prior to playing his or her first match, subject to the provision of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c).
 - a) Any player taking part in a Lancashire and Cheshire League match between the start of any season and the 31st December of the same year must have

played up to the 31st December of that season at least 3 matches in the League he/she represents in the Lancashire and Cheshire League, otherwise that player's registration will be automatically cancelled for the remainder of that season and any sets won by that player will be awarded to his/her opponents, except as provided for in paragraph (c). An emergency registration may be advised by email or fax, the official form being submitted by the next available post.

- b) Any player taking part in a Lancashire and Cheshire League match after 31st December in any season must have played at least 3 matches in that League's domestic competition in the first half of that season, except as provided for in paragraph (c).
 - c) The provisions and conditions of paragraphs (a) and (b) may be waived at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- 4) Each League must nominate with the Hon. General Secretary, the names of its players in order of playing strength. The first 3 players on the list will be eligible to play in the first team, the next 3 will constitute the second team, and so on, according to the number of teams entered. A player may play for a higher team than that for which he has been ranked, but having played for a higher team on 3 occasions, he/she shall be re-ranked and shall not be eligible to play for a lower team without first obtaining permission from the Hon. General Secretary. The first list must be received by the Hon. General Secretary prior to the commencement of fixtures. Alterations to the ranking list must be submitted by the 25th of each month and will be operative from the 1st of the next month, unless notified to the contrary. Players may be ranked on the score card in any order except where matches are played on a group basis.
- 5) No player shall be permitted to play for more than one League in any one season. The only exception shall be a transfer between two Leagues which has been agreed by the Executive Committee.
- 6) Qualification date for Juniors: Players must be under 18 years of age on 1st January in the current season.
- a) Players 40 years of age and over on 1st August in each year shall be eligible to play in the Veterans Section.
- 7) The Home League shall advise its opponents, at least 14 days before the match, of the venue and starting time. The away league will only need to contact its opponents if they have not received confirmation of the match or they are unable to fulfill the fixture (see regulation 3). Failure to receive confirmation does not give the away league the right not to play the match but if the matter is reported to the hon. general secretary the offending league may be fined.
- a) Communications can be made by post, email or fax.
 - b) A home league can elect to declare its home venue for all the season's matches. The address, start time and directions may be published in the handbook. These leagues would be excused from rule 7a unless there is a change of venue, where rule 7a would still apply.

- c) A minimum of 3 days notice shall be required for a change of venue unless mutually agreed by both leagues. Failure to comply may result in the match being awarded to the away league.
- 8) All matches shall be played on the dates stated in the handbook. If a home league advises its opponents of a loss of venue, the away league may offer to play the match at its home venue on the same date. If this is not acceptable, the match shall be awarded to the away league.
- In the case of all walkovers, the executive committee shall, after considering the circumstances as to why the match was not played, award points as follows:-
- Award all of the points to one of the teams;
 - Award 5 points to one or each of the teams;
 - Award no points to either team;
 - Decide the result (based on both teams being at full strength).
- If any team gives more than one walkover in any one season then all of that team's results shall be expunged and the said team shall apply for re-entry the following season.**
- 9) If any League fails to fulfil a fixture or plays with an incomplete team, it shall be fined £5.00 per missing player or, in extenuating circumstances, the Executive can waive the fine.
- Teams to consist of 3 players. A match cannot be played with less than 2 players in either team. Depending on the circumstances as to why a team has fielded 2 players short the executive committee shall decide the result under Match Regulation 8. If the match is taking place on a weekend group basis then all the results of that team shall be expunged and appropriate fines imposed.
- 10) Playing conditions must conform to the following rules:-
- Matches may be played on any make of Table conforming to English Table Tennis Association rules, and shall be played with an approved E.T.T.A. ball.
 - The lighting in all matches shall be such that the amount of light in all parts of the playing space shall be at least equal to that which would be provided by 3 main lights, the centre light of 200 watts being not less than 8 feet and no more than 10 feet from the Floor, the two end lights extending 2 feet over each end of the table, not less than 10 feet and no more than 12 feet from the floor and being not less than 100 watts in strength. All lights shall be shaded. Fluorescent lighting must not be used, except as secondary lighting.
 - All matches to be played on Tables of not less than 1 inch nominal playing surface.
 - In Premier and Divisions 1 and 2, the unrestricted playing space shall be NOT less than 30 feet by 18 feet.
 - In all other Divisions, the unrestricted playing space shall be not less than 30 feet by 16 feet.
- 11) The various divisions shall play their matches as follows:-
- Each team shall play other teams in its Division at least once in each season.

- b) Teams shall consist of not less than three players nor more than five players, except in those divisions where the matches are staged on a group basis. The three players for singles shall play each member of the other side, one set, best of five games. In addition, two players (not necessarily the same as in singles) shall play a doubles match against two of the other side, one set, best of five games.
 - c) Except in divisions where matches are staged on a group basis, the sets shall be played in the following order:- 1 v 2; 3 v 1; 2 v 3; 3 v 2; 1 v 3. Doubles: 2 v 1; 3 v 3; 2 v 2; 1 v 1. Home teams first in each case. In divisions where matches are staged on a group basis, the sets shall be played in the following order:- 1 v 2; 2 v 1; 3 v 3; 1 v 1; 3 v 2; 2 v 3.
 - d) If a player is absent when called upon to play, a reserve may be nominated in his or her place and this reserve, once nominated, shall play throughout the entire match.
 - e) Umpires shall be agreed mutually; failing agreement, it shall be the responsibility of the Home League to provide umpires.
 - f) If a player, or pair of players, is/are absent when due to play, the set shall be awarded to the opponent or opponents. Two minutes grace shall be allowed.
 - g) All matches shall commence not later than 8.00 p.m. If a team is not represented within 30 minutes of the agreed time of starting, their opponents shall have the option of claiming the match.
 - h) All matches shall be played to a finish, but if through exceptional circumstances a match is left unfinished, these circumstances must be reported to the Hon. General Secretary who may award the un-played games to one or other of the teams, but he may consult the Executive Committee if he should consider it advisable, in which case the match shall be regarded as undecided pending the decision of the Executive Committee Meeting. A League refusing to complete the ten sets of a match after a winning lead has been obtained, may be penalised by loss of points.
 - i) One point shall be awarded for each set won. In the event of a tie on points, the winner will be decided by the ratio of games won to games lost, points won to points lost. Should the teams still be equal, then a play-off shall take place at a neutral venue. (Best of 9 sets [no doubles] to be decided by the Executive Committee. (Not applicable to matches played on a group basis).
- 12) Score cards with the result of the match must be forwarded to the Hon. General Secretary by post. A fine of £5.00 shall be imposed if the score card has not been received within 7 days of the match and £5.00 for each week or part of a week thereafter.
- 13) The Hon. General Secretary shall, in December, January, February and March each season, send all match results and up-to-date league tables to all League General Secretaries and all Lancashire and Cheshire League Match Secretaries.
- 14) The number of divisions in each season will be decided upon by the executive committee, depending on new entries received each year. Promotion and relegation will apply to all divisions (except juniors), the bottom two teams being relegated to the next lower division available for the following season. The winner

and runner-up of each division will be promoted to the next higher division available for the following season. New teams of known strength will be placed in a suitable division should a vacancy occur. The executive committee shall have the right to promote or relegate teams to adjust the numbers in any division to suit current needs i.e. smaller or larger divisions. Formation of the junior divisions will be decided each season based on the information supplied from each League in relation to the expected playing strength of each team for the coming season. The executive committee will group the teams by playing strength. Cups and awards to be made for the top 2 in each division.

- 15) It shall be the responsibility of a member League changing its Secretary or a Secretary changing his/her address to notify within 3 days the following people: The General Secretary of the Lancashire & Cheshire League, the Secretary of each League in the Divisions in which his team or teams play.
- 16) **PROTESTS AND APPEALS.** Protests and Appeals relating to any violation of the Laws of the Game or the Match Regulations of the League shall be lodged by the protesting League with the Hon. General Secretary within seven days (Sundays excepted) after playing the match in respect of which the protest or complaint arises, accompanied by a deposit of £3.00 which shall be forfeited if the protest or complaint is not upheld. A full copy of the protest or appeal shall also be sent to the Secretary of the League protested against at the same time as the protest is sent to the Hon. General Secretary. All protests shall be made out fully stating the rule under which it is made. Any failure to comply with these rules or with the relevant rules of the English Table Tennis Association or the Laws of the Game shall not entitle the opposing League to refuse to play a match, but may be a ground for an appeal if the League is seriously prejudiced in its arrangements or in its play. No amendment of or addition to a protest shall be allowed and it will be ignored if out of time.
- 17) **WITHDRAWAL FROM LEAGUE**
- a) If a team withdraws from the league then all of that team's results shall be expunged from the league records and the offending league shall be fined in accordance with match regulation 9 for any uncompleted matches. Where a team has withdrawn without playing a match and the fixtures have been compiled, the offending league shall be fined in accordance with match regulation 9 except that if sufficient notice is given (minimum 21 days) and a suitable replacement can be found, then the executive committee can, at its discretion, waive the fine.
 - b) Where matches are played on a group basis, any team who fails to complete all of its fixtures shall have all existing results expunged from the league records and the offending league shall be fined in accordance with regulation 9.
- 18) **CUPS AND TROPHIES.** All persons and Leagues receiving Cups and Trophies of the League do so on the following conditions:-
- a) The Cups and Trophies cannot be won outright.
 - b) The recipient shall sign a receipt and an undertaking drafted by the Executive Committee to be handed over when the Cup or Trophy is received.

- c) In the event of any League becoming defunct, or in the event of any person leaving the country for a period exceeding one month at a time whilst holding a League Cup or Trophy, then the Cup or Trophy shall be returned to the Hon. General Secretary by such person or League.
- d) The Cup or Trophy shall not, under any circumstances, be taken out of England.
- e) The holder shall keep the Cup or Trophy in proper condition and shall be responsible for any damage thereto, except in so far as any insurance money is recovered in respect of same.
- f) The Cup or Trophy shall be returned without any request being made, to the Hon. General Secretary, at least a month before the competition or the final of the competition in the following year is held. Should any Trophy not be returned prior to the date of the A.G.M., the offending League shall be fined in the amount of £10.00.

APPEAL BOARD REGULATIONS

1. A Clerk to the Board of Appeal will be appointed by the Executive Committee of the Lancashire & Cheshire League, This person will hereinafter be referred to as "The Appeal Clerk".
2. All appeals under rule 13 or match regulation 16 must be sent to the Secretary of the Lancashire and Cheshire League, hereinafter referred to as "The Hon. General Secretary", who shall forward the appeal letter to the Appeal Clerk within seven days of receipt of such appeal.
3. The Appeal Clerk shall upon receipt of notice of appeal, contact three persons who qualify under rule 13, nominate one as Chairman, arrange date, time and venue for hearing, which date shall not be later than 5 weeks after the date of receipt of notice of the appeal by the Appeal Clerk.
4. The Appeal Clerk shall then:
 - (a) advise all parties concerned of the date, time and venue of the hearing, giving at least 14 days clear notice.
 - (b) send all parties concerned, copy of the appeal letter and any correspondence relating to it.
5. The Appeal Clerk shall attend the hearing in order to take minutes of the proceedings. He/she shall not be entitled to speak or vote at the hearing, except to advise upon matters of procedure, if requested to do so.
6. All appeals must comply with the timescales as per rule 13 and match regulation 16 and must state acceptable grounds for such appeal.

Note: It is the responsibility of the Appeal Board to uphold the rules and match regulations of the Lancashire & Cheshire League and to deliver recommendations that are both viable and operable by the executive committee.

CUP COMPETITIONS REGULATIONS

1. Cup competitions will be held annually as follows:- The Norman Cook Memorial Trophy (Open), The Mabel Neary Cup (Women) and The Dennis Smith Memorial Trophy (Vets). All Leagues in membership of the Lancashire & Cheshire League will be eligible to enter one team. The winners will be awarded the relevant trophy which they will hold for one year. Where leagues have entered teams in both the Norman Cook and Dennis Smith competitions, they must have sufficient players available should both teams reach the finals which are played on the same evening. It is requested that teams involved in the finals evening arrive in good time for a prompt start. Players who are absent when called upon to play will forfeit the set.
2. Teams will consist of 3 players. Matches will be played in the following order:-
1 v 2, 3 v 1, 2 v 3, 3 v 2, 1 v 3, 2 v 1, 3 v 3, 2 v 2, 1 v 1.
3. All matches shall be the best of three games 21 up.
4. Teams may rank their players in any order except that each team shall do so on separate match score sheets without knowledge of their opponents order.
5. The finals of these competitions shall be played on dates, times and venues to be decided by the Executive Committee. The teams in each final shall draw lots to decide who shall be home or away.
6. On receipt of the draw, the home team shall, within 7 days, offer the away team 2 dates on which it is convenient for the match to be played, giving at least 14 days notice. The away team shall, within 7 days, accept one of the dates offered. Failure by the home league to offer the dates within 7 days will give the away league the right to claim home advantage. Failure by the away league to accept one of the dates offered will result in the tie being awarded to the home team.
7. Any player taking part in these competitions must conform to regulations 3(a) and 3(b).
8. In all cup competitions the Executive Committee shall handicap each individual player and a list will be sent to each team secretary prior to the commencement of each competition. Where both players in an individual match are in receipt of the same handicap e.g. 5 points, the commencing score in each game shall be love all. Where the players are in receipt of different handicaps e.g. 4 and 7, the player with the higher handicap shall commence each game at 3 love and so on.
9. Any matter not covered by these regulations shall be decided by the normal rules and match regulations of the Lancashire & Cheshire League.

The Jack Livingstone Memorial Trophy (Juniors) shall be competed for on an annual basis. A suitable playing format shall be decided by the executive committee.
