Code of conduct for adult members

Maldon Table Tennis Club (MTTC) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members, ensuring a positive and enjoyable experience for all. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open always and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the General Secretary or a Committee Member.

As a member of MTTC, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the rules, policies and procedures, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by Committee members, volunteers and coaches. They give their time and resources to provide Table Tennis for you.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
- All members should be a positive role model, treat other players and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs on club premises
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and League games or inform their team captain if they are going to be late.

- Members must wear suitable sports kit for training and match sessions.
- Members must pay any fees due promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
