The Shippam Shield Handicap Competition

Please note the committee has decided that all Shippam Shield matches cannot be postponed except for extreme bad weather.

All match cards are the responsibility of the winning team and must reach the match secretary on the following dates :

Round 1.. Results must be in by the 24th November 2014

Round 2.. Results must be in by the 16th February 2014

Semi Final Results must be in by the 6th April 2014

Failure to keep to the above dates may cause the offending team to be scratched from the Shippam Shield competition.

Will all team secretaries also note that rule 10 will be adhered to this year and that any change to the 3 strongest players must be in 14 days prior to the beginning of the Shippam Shield match week.

Any team fielding a stronger player after the 14 day cut off date (with or without permission) will incur a 60 point penalty against said player. This will be checked when the score card is processed and may change the final match result.

GENERAL RULES

1. Title

This organisation shall be called "THE MANSFIELD & DISTRICT TABLE TENNIS LEAGUE" (hereafter referred to as The League) and shall be affiliated to the ETTA and the Notts TTA.

2. Objects

The objects of the League shall be :-

- A. To foster and promote organised Table Tennis.
- B. To use its influence towards better facilities for the game.
- C. To endeavour to improve the standard of play.

3. Radius

The League shall be confined to clubs within the Mansfield & District area.

Consideration may be given to applications from teams outside the Mansfield & District area.

4. Government

The League shall be governed by a committee (elected at the Annual General Meeting) consisting of :-

President, Chairman, Vice Chairman, General Secretary, Treasurer, Competition / Trophies Officer, Records / Website Officer, Coaching Development Officers.

The committee shall have the power to co-opt as necessary to maintain a working committee.

All officials shall be honorary

The General Secretary shall $\,$ receive an honorarium of £100.00 (One Hundred pounds) per annum.

The financial year shall end on 31st May

5. Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than the end of July.

At least seven days notice of the meeting shall be given to all clubs.

A fine of £10.00 (ten pounds) shall be levied on any team failing to ensure representation at the Annual General Meeting.

Each registered player or League Official present at the Annual General Meeting is entitled to vote.

6. Special General Meeting

On receipt of a requisition, signed by at least 25% of team secretaries in membership of The League, the General Secretary shall convene a Special General Meeting.

7. Quorums

Three members shall constitute a quorum for the committee.

25% of the teams in membership of The League shall constitute a quorum at the General Meeting.

8. Registrations

Application Forms for teams and players registration shall be in the hands of the Handbook Secretary before 26th August and must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Any player registered after 26th August is to be notified to the General Secretary not less than 48 (forty eight) hours before a match.

No player may be registered after 31st December unless there are exceptional circumstances, in which event the facts must be submitted to the committee for special consideration.

The player registration fees shall entitle players to affiliation to the ETTA and a copy of the League handbook.

The committee shall have the power to refuse or revoke registrations that are not in the interest of The League.

9. Fees

Teams :- Entrance fee to The League shall be £50.00 (fifty pounds) per team.

Players:- In addition to the team fee, the following fees are payable.

Senior Players :- £10.00 (ten pounds) each. Junior Players :- £5.00 (five pounds) each.

All fees are to be paid before the commencement of the season.

10. Junior Players

The term "Junior" shall apply to players whose 18th (eighteenth) birthday falls on or after 1st January following the commencement of the season

11. Payment of Fines

All outstanding fines are to be paid before the commencement of the season.

Fines imposed during the current playing season shall be paid to the Treasurer within 28 (twenty eight) days of notification.

Non-payment of fines may lead to suspension of a player, team or club.

If a team resigns from the League for any reasons whatsoever, any player of that team must pay their share of any money owed before being allowed to register for another club.

12. Trophies

All perpetual trophies are the property of The League.

The League will provide free of charge individual trophies, up to a maximum of 4 per team, for relevant team competitions.

Clubs holding team trophies and players holding individual trophies will be held responsible for their safe custody and return to the Competitions / Trophies Officer by 1st March.

Any losses or damages are to be made good by the individual or club concerned.

13. Transfer of Players

Registrations are not transferable.

Any player wishing to join another club must obtain the permission of the Secretary of their existing club and also that of The League Committee.

14. Proposed Alterations Of Rules

Additions and amendments to these rules shall only be made at the Annual General Meeting.

Proposals to alter these rules must be in the hands of the General Secretary not later than 28 (twenty eight) days prior to the Annual General Meeting and a copy of the suggested rule change(s) to be sent with the Annual General Meeting notices.

15. Powers of The Committee

The Committee shall have full power to deal with any matters not already provided for in these rules.

IMPORTANT DATES

Yuletide Competition will be held at the Ravenshead Leisure Centre on Monday: 29th Dec 2014 at 7.30pm.

Annual Championships will be held at the Ravenshead Leisure Centre on Sunday 1st March 2015 from 9.00am - 5.30pm.

Mick Dennis Trophy will be held at the Ravenshead Leisure Centre on Monday 20th April 2015.

This is a competition for division 2 players over 50 years of age.

Presentation Night will be held at the Summit Centre on Friday the 25th of April 2015 at 7.30pm.

Annual General Meeting will be held at the Ravenshead Leisure Centre on the 2nd of July 2015 at 7.30pm.

LEAGUE AND COMPETITION RULES

Application for membership to The League shall imply acceptance of the Rules of The League.

All League and Competition Matches shall be played in accordance with current ETTA Laws.

3. League(s) Formation

All Divisions of the League shall comprise of not more than twelve teams. Each team will have a maximum of eight registered players.

Additional registrations will only be allowed at the discretion of the committee.

The League fixtures shall be arranged by the committee and issued at least one week prior to the first matches being played.

System of Playing - League

There shall be ten points awarded for each match played.

One point shall be awarded for each rubber won, leaving league positions to be decided on rubbers won.

In the event of only two players turning up from each team, of the unplayed five rubbers, two points shall be awarded to each team with the remaining point being decided on the outcome of the doubles.

Teams must fulfil their fixtures in accordance with the fixture list.

All matches shall start no later than 7.30pm, subject to access to premises, and be played in strict score card order unless by mutual, prior agreement between opposing team representatives.

If a player is absent when his game is called, he shall forfeit the game.

Two Teams in One Division

Any player may assist another team(s) in the same club, provided his or her ranking is of equal or lower ranking than the lowest ranked player in that team.

Registration of Players

Any club wishing to enter more than one team shall submit a separate list of players for each team to the General Secretary. To avoid confusion between a club and a team, a club must rank each team in order of standard.

Any player may assist his club by playing in a higher ranked team than that for which he or she is registered in, up to three occasions without penalty.

After three occasions the Committee shall have the power to change his or her registration to that of the higher ranked team.

No player can play for a lower ranked team.

7. Playing of Ineligible Players

Any team playing an ineligible player shall lose the match 10-0.

8. Notification of Results

In all matches the winning team shall be responsible for the result card, giving full details of the players and the scores, being posted to the Records Officer, within 48 (forty eight) hours of the match taking place.

The cards shall be signed by one of the opposing players.

In the event of a draw the home team shall post the card.

9. Re-arrangement of Matches

Postponement of matches shall be by mutual consent of the two teams concerned.

Both teams must submit a score card giving details of the postponement and any re-arrangement to the Records Officer to arrive not later than 48 (forty eight) hours after the scheduled date of the fixture.

The postponing team must give opponents at least 48 (forty eight) hours notice of the postponement.

No match shall be postponed more than once.

All scheduled league matches must be completed by the official end of the league fixtures.

League matches taking place after this date will be void.

Failure to observe this procedure will automatically cause the postponing team to forfeit the points.

In the event of a team failing to turn up for a fixture as agreed by the Committee, if that team has not been notified by the opposing Team Secretary, then that team will automatically forfeit the match 10-0.

10. Shippam Shield Matches

Where a team has more than three players, these matches will be handicapped on the three highest ranked players. In the event that a team is not going to play their three highest ranked players in these matches, they must notify the Competition / Trophies Officer or the Records Officer of their team at least 14 (fourteen) days prior to the scheduled date of the match. This will enable the handicapping to fairly reflect the standard of the team.

No player will be allowed to substitute for any another team, they can only play for the team for which they are registered.

The format for this competition is nine singles of two games of 21 up. IE:- Change serves every five. Deuce is to be played out to win the game by two clear points.

11. Change of Club Details

Each team shall be responsible for notifying the General Secretary and all Team Secretaries in the appropriate Division of any changes relating to the details published in the handbook of their Team Secretary, playing quarters or home nights.

12. Fines

The Committee shall have the power to fine any player, team or club, a sum not exceeding £25.00 (twenty five pounds) for each contravention of these rules.

13. Claims

Any individual or club may appeal against any action or an Officer of the

Any such appeal shall be made in writing to the General Secretary within 21 (twenty one) days of the decision or action against which the appeal is made.

This appeal must be accompanied by a fee of £5.00 (five pounds) which shall be returned if in the view of the adjudicating body, the appeal was justified (whatever the decision).

Either party to the appeal shall be entitled to be heard by the adjudicating body.



A GOOD SERVICE

Service shall start with the ball resting freely on the open palm of the server's <u>stationary</u> free hand.

The server shall then project the ball near vertically upwards, without imparting spin, so that it rises at least 16cm after leaving the palm of the free hand and then falls without touching anything before being struck.

As the ball is falling the server shall strike it so that it touches first his court and then, after passing over or around the net assembly, touches directly the receiver's court; in doubles, the ball shall touch successively the right half court of server and receiver.

From the start of service until it is struck, the ball shall be above the level of the playing surface and behind the server's end line, and it shall not be hidden from the receiver by any part of the body or clothing of the server or his doubles partner; as soon as the ball has been projected, the server's free arm shall be removed from the space between the server's body and the net.

It is the responsibility of the player to serve so that the umpire or the assistant umpire can see that he complies with the requirements for a good service.

If the umpire is doubtful of the legality of a service he may, on the first occasion in a match, declare a let and warm the server.

Any subsequent service of doubtful legality of that player or his doubles partner will result in a point to the receiver.

Whenever there is a clear failure to comply with the requirements for a good service no warning shall be given and the receiver shall score a point.

Exceptionally, the umpire may relax the requirements for a good service where he is satisfied that compliance is prevented by physical disability.

THE EXPEDITE SYSTEM

Except where both players or pairs have scored at least 9 points, the expedite system shall come into operation if a game is unfinished after 10 minutes' play or at any earlier time at the request of both players or pairs.

If the ball is in play when the time limit is reached, play shall be interrupted by the umpire and shall resume with service by the player who served in the rally that was interrupted. If the ball is not in play when the time limit is reached, play shall resume with service by the player who received in the immediate preceding rally.

player who received in the immediate preceding rally.

Thereafter, each player shall serve for 1 point in turn until the end of the game and if the receiving player or pair makes 13 good returns, the receiver shall score a point.

Once introduced the system shall remain in operation until the end of the match.

A copy of the complete laws of Table Tennis approved by the ETTA will be supplied to each Team Secretary on request, by the General Secretary.




