REGULATIONS

Qualification:

The Championships are open to all players who are

- (a) Registered with a club which plays in a league affiliated to Cornwall County TTA (CCTTA)
- (b) Registered with a club that is directly affiliated to CCTTA or (c) directly affiliated to CCTTA.
- (c) Must of played a minimum of three league matches prior to the closing date of the event unless extreme circumstances are excepted by the County Committee.

Seeding

Please be aware that the County Committee has agreed that players entering the County Closed for this season will need to play one third of local league matches in order to be eligible to be seeded at this event.

Players must not appear on the ranking list of another County. Age- related events:

Under 12's must have been born after 31st December 2004 Cadets must have been born after 31st December 2001 Juniors must have been born after 31st December 1998 Under 21's must have been born after 31st December 1995 Veterans must have been born before 1st January 1977 Over 55 Veterans must have been born before 1st January 1962

Mixed events:

Events 7, 8 11, 12 and 13 are open to both male and female players.

Junior Team Knock Out:

This event is open to teams of 2 players **both of whom must be bona-fide players of the same club or school.** Matches will consist of 5 games - 4 crossover singles and one doubles. Each match will finish as soon as one team has **3** wins.

Rackets:

One surface of the racket must be Red and the other must be Black.

Generally:

Matches will be the best of 5 games up to 11 points. All singles will, if possible, be played in groups of 3 or more with the players finishing first and second in each group progressing to the Knock Out rounds.

Play will be on 9 Joola Blue tables (more if the entry requires) using 3 Star white plastic balls. Car parking and changing rooms with showers will be available.

The organisers reserve the right to delete events due to lack of entries
