Following the confirmation of our governance reforms at the recent EGM I am pleased to say that we are now in a position to proceed officially with the Be TT programme.

I am delighted to say that after an extensive assessment process you have been successful with your expression of interest, and we would love to work with you to build better TT experiences in the Portishead & Bristol area. Other applications from the area have also been successful and where possible we will expect a joined up approach to ensure the best use of resources.

The next steps for the programme are:

- 1. Send out the BeTT membership satisfaction survey to your area. As you are aware, Be TT aims to build better experiences and we will use this survey to find out how happy people are, and what things they want improved as well as using the survey as a measurement tool throughout the project. - 3. Complete an audit of current provision in your area (attached). This must be completed in order for us to gain a full picture, but we can complete this with you either before or during the first meeting. Please complete what you can in the meantime. We will cross reference this with the insight data we already have for your area and we can present this at the first Be TT meeting. We will also look to produce infographics for your area like the attached national picture of competitive players.
