All member clubs should formally endorse this policy at a properly constituted Club Committee Meeting.
- All members of SDTTL and visitors to any SDTTL matches must adhere to the Safeguarding Guidelines of Table Tennis England. These guidelines are published as <u>downloadable</u> <u>documents</u> and include specific Codes of Conduct and Guidance for
 - o Coaches
 - o Officials
 - o Players
 - o Parents
- Anyone in breach of this Code shall be liable to disciplinary action in accordance with the League's existing Rules.
