CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

1. I.T.T.F Laws of Table Tennis shall apply to this Tournament. I.T.T.F Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (*). I.T.T.F Regulations can be found on www.ittf.com
2. Every entrant must be affiliated to the Table Tennis Association of Wales with a current Player Membership or be a member of a National Association in membership of the I.T.T.F.
3. Completion and submission of this entry form, signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition.
4. Entrants in the over 40 events must be born before 1st of January 1980. Entrants in other aged events must have obtained the appropriate age before the date of the tournament.
5. Players may enter a maximum of three events that they are eligible for. The three entries may cover (a) 3 singles only, (b) 2 singles + 1 doubles, (c) 1 singles, 1 doubles + mixed doubles.
6. All singles events will be drawn in qualifying groups of four, wherever possible. Seeded players will be required to play in the groups. The winner and runner up in each group will qualify for the Main Competition. Players finishing third and fourth in their group will qualify for the Plate Competition. The final positions in each group will be decided in accordance with I.T.T.F Regulation 3.7.5. All matches will be best of five games.
7. All doubles matches will generally be played on a knockout wherever possible and will be best of five games.
8. All competitors must report to the control table on arrival each day, and must not leave the hall without permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
9. All **LOSING** competitors will be required to umpire.
10. **Clothing:** The main colour of a shirt, skirt or shorts, other than the sleeves and collar of a shirt shall be clearly different from that of the ball in use.
11. **Rackets:** ITTF Regulations: 3.2.1.3, 3.4.2.2.apply. A list of approved racket coverings can be found on www.ittf.com
12. **Time - Out:** ITTF Regulation 3.4.4.2. for time-out does not apply (*)
13. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law on any question not provided for in these regulations or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by an umpire or assistant umpire appointed by the referee shall be final.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

2. **Draw** – The draw will take place at 7p.m. on Wednesday 18th March 2020 at 8 Harford Close, Bristol BS9 2QD.
3. No refunds will be given after the draw.
4. Admission - There will be no charge for admission to the venue.
5. **Playing Conditions** – Play throughout will be on up to 18 Butterfly Tables with Butterfly Nets and posts, Stag Xushaofa white 3* balls, high frequency fluorescent overhead lighting, wood sprung sports floor. Court size 10m x 5m. Ceiling height 22m
6. Practice – There will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practice on tables not in use at the discretion of the referee.
7. **Refreshments** – Refreshments are available at the venue.
8. **Changing** – The Centre offers full changing and shower facilities.
9. **Car Parking** – Car parking (at owner's risk) is available at the venue.
10. **Notification** – Competitors will be notified of the starting times of their matches either via email or by post if a stamped addressed envelope is enclosed.
11. The organisers can accept no liability for injuries to competitors or for the loss of personal possessions during the Championships.
12. Racket testing may take place.
13. No glueing of rackets is allowed at the venue.
14. **Time outs** – There are no Time outs at this event
