Minute of Annual General Meeting 2021/2022 Held at Drumchapel Sports Centre 29 May 2022

2 Acceptance of Minutes of the 2020/21 AGM proposed by C O'Neill, seconded by J Kerr.

3 Matters Arising from the Minutes.

P McCallum noted that the updated Constitution distributed with the Minutes contains a reference to "the Scottish Table Tennis Association" when this should now be "Table Tennis Scotland". The meeting was asked to approve this minor change to the Constitution and gave unanimous consent.

4 Officers' Reports

- 4.3 The Match Secretary's Report is attached as Appendix 4.
- 4.4 The Tournament Secretary made no report due to there having been no tournaments.

4.5 The Development Coordinator made no report due to there having been no development activity. It was noted, however, that development will restart next season, being overseen by T McLernon and P McCallum.

5 The Treasurer's report (see Appendix 1) was submitted, indicating a surplus of £962 and a current Balance of £10,342.

The accounts were then approved with no queries or dissent.

6 No amendments to the Constitution had been submitted other than that raised and approved at paragraph 3 above.

7 No motions had been submitted.

8 No nominations had been submitted for Honorary Life Membership of the League. However, it was disclosed to the meeting that Phil Gordon had experienced a serious health problem as a consequence of which he will no longer be able to participate in the League or its administration. P McCallum therefore proposed, seconded by R Claxton, that, in recognition of his many years as an EC member and Honorary Auditor, Phil should be granted Honorary Life Membership of the League and this was approved unanimously. 9 The only nominations for Committee membership were those submitted by the outgoing committee. However, since those nominations, P Gordon has withdrawn due to illness and L Elliott has decided to stand down. All other nominations were accepted and the new Committee membership is therefore:

Honoraria were reinstated as per the "old" (pre-pandemic) status quo and are therefore: Match Secretary (£165), General Secretary (£110), Treasurer (£165), Development Coordinator (£165), Webmaster (£55), League Managers (£30) and £20 to M Montgomery in recognition of his efforts re TT365. Honoraria were waived by L Hughes and L Elliott.

14 The Match Secretary then announced the Top Player awards for the year. These are detailed at the end of his report (Appendix 4).

2.1 Notes to Income and Expenditure

Over the course of the year, the league ran at a surplus of £962 (£567 in 2021). Of that surplus, £314 can be attributed to development.

2.1.1 Bank Balance

Closing bank balance is £10,342, which is derived from an opening balance of £9,320, net corrections from 2020/2021 of £60 (cash held not yet banked of £90 and unpresented cheques from 2019/2020 of £30) with trading surplus 2021/2022 of £962.

2.1.2 Development

£2,803 of closing balance is attributed to development (opening balance of £2,489 and surplus of £314).

4 Report

Once again, the league remained cash positive over the course of the year and is in a healthy position with a total of £10,342 in the bank account.

The work done in the 2020/2021 season to develop an online banking facility has significantly simplified our transaction management. In this year, I'm pleased to confirm that **every single** transaction has been carried out electronically (both incoming and outgoing).

The league also acquired a credit card facility through Sumup which supports both online payments and in-person card transactions via a portable unit (one off cost of £24). Transactions via Sumup do incur additional fees (fees totalled £11 this year). The convenience of remote payment far outweigh the associated costs. We will continue to offer online and card transactions for personal payment of tournament and inter league participation. Note that club/player fees via invoice are only supported via BACS transfer, and as such do not incur any bank fees.

This is the first year that we have used the Freeagent software for management and preparation of accounts. A new process was introduced, where clubs were sent an invoice detailing their player registration costs based on the team/player spreadsheets submitted. Invoices are easily generated within Freeagent, and show bank details for BACS transfer (helping ensure electronic payment). Example invoices are shown at the end of this report. Use of Freeagent has significantly simplified both the invoice and payment process, and the software will continue to be used.

4.1 Sports Council for Glasgow

During preparation of the accounts it was noted that the previous method of payment for Sports Council for Glasgow has failed (their direct debit request was on our previous bank account). Membership will continue (cost is just £10)), and will be processed early in 2022/2023 financial year.

4.2 Change of Auditor

The Treasurer and Executive Committee would like to express thanks to Phil Gordon for auditing the accounts of the League in previous years. Unfortunately due to illness, Phil was unable to carry out his audit this year.

The Treasurer and Executive Committee would like to express sincere thanks to Senga Thomson for stepping in as Auditor as the last minute.
