

Second county crown sealed for Andrew after clinching title in the pairs

Double joy for Hodges

ANDREW Hodges clinched his second men's singles title at the Wiltshire Closed Championships at Westbury's Matravers Sports Hall on Sunday.

Hodges beat seven-time winner and Hilpertont club-mate Marcin Jaskolski in a close contested semi-final - winning the fifth and final leg 16-14 before going on to see off Westbury's Lee Phillips in the final, who himself had come through a tough last-four clash against last year's junior winner Tom Barrett.

The open doubles was again won by Hodges and Jaskolski in a thrilling final against Phillips and Hilpertont's Albert Bolhuis - their seventh doubles crown.

The ladies event was again won by Poulshot's Julie Dean, who has now won seven county singles titles, beating Chippenham's Brenda Baldwin in a close final.
