MEMO from E.T.T.A. National Umpires and Referees Committee:

As a result of decisions taken at the I.T.T.F. BCM, the following changes to the laws of Table Tennis and the regulation for international competitions come into effect from 1st. Sept 1 They will be included in the next edition of the I.T.T.F. Rules Booklet, which should be available in about a month.

LAWS

- 3.6.1. At the start of service the ball, but not necesse 'ly the whole of the free hand, must be behind the server's end line
- 3.6.6.1. On the first occasion in a match on which he is doubtfu of the legality of a player's service, the umpire may warn a player without awarding a point.
- 3.11. Foot stamping in service will not automatically incur the loss of a point.
- 3.16.1. The expedite system will not come into operation automatically after 15 minutes play if both players or pairs have seemed at least 19 points.


