A GOOD SERVICE.

Due to a number of complaints re juniors plus a incident in a recent town match with regard to E.T.T.A. law 6,I was requested to ensure we print the law in the Horn for all to read Due to the length of the law (13 parts) and the fact that all players/officials can readily and easily obtain the laws of T/T I have decided against this at present in order to point out me of the areas of illegal serving causing the

most concern
Ball not thrown up min of 16cm (6ins) from flat
of hand

Ball hit straight out of hand
Ball allowed to drop downwards no throw up at all
Free hand and ball held over table to commence
service

Some players have developed habits over years in order to improve and do not realize they are breaking the law but others know full well what they are doing

At all tournaments/rep matches umpires are urged to tighten up on service law as juniors should well know already, I try to teach juniors that what they try in the local league, they may well not get away with at a higher level and more importantly ould not

It is up to all players and umpires to require a good service, rember it is the players resposibility to serve so that the umpire can seethat he complies with the requirements for a good service. No coach that I have ever worked with teaches any one to foul serve, but I would point out that juniors learn quickly and very much copy senior players.

DRESS.

While on my soap box the wearing of white or white based shirts plus shirts with large fronted logos is also illegal as all juniors are told only for them to point out the seniors that break the law
