REGIONAL TRAINING CENTRE

This is the new name for the restyled Centres of Excellence, New Ferry Village Hall Has this week been chosen as the R.T.C for Merseyside as one of 3 centres in the North West, one is already operational at Northwich, and the other to be located at Preston.

The centre will commence on Wed. Dec. 1st 7-30 - 9-30 pm and thenevery wednesdaexcept in holiday periods. At the most only 12 of the most promising players can attend by invitation only, and these have now been selected following trials. This I'm afraid make cause problems for the Gautby Road teams as at least 7 of their players are involved, playing league matches is not an excuse for attending training, and while every effort will be made to overcome this there will be times when there will be a need to re-arrange matches, We hope that Clubs will try to help with this for the rest of the season.

Coaches in attendance will be Stan Clarke & Les Jones and we would invite any of Wirrals top players to come along and help, which will be much appreciated!

R.T.C. is the first step for Wirral to be in line for the location of one of 4 'Participation Centres' to be set up in the North West in the next 2-3 years. A consortium of the E.T.T.A. The Sports Council, Focus in Sport and the local Council will buy premises or convert existing ones e.g. Arrowe Park to a high degree to be used for Table Tennis 5 nights per week and all week-ends, and used for other purposes in the day-time, these are serious proposals and the setting up of the R.T.C. here will put Wirral in the front line for one of these projects.

These things don't happen on their own, a lot of work has been going on behind the scenes, and thanks are due to many people not least to Nickie at New Ferry, staff at Gautby Rd and officers of Leisure Services, and a special thankyou to C Eaton N.W, coaching adminissrator who has fought very hard to back Wirral for these projects.
