We have now the plaYing conditions which are the envy of leagues all over the North of England - BUT - Who is going to pay to keep it running, our grant we hope, will take care of MOST of the initial work, but the H.Q is running at a loss on a day to day basis, it can't survive unless it is used, and when I say Used. I mean used and payment is made for the usethereof, we don't ask a lot 50p a session is ludicrous you must agree, we are going to put the charge up to £1 per visit, compare this with a round of golf or avisit to the cinema. The annual charge is still £5 for this season, which allows the person who pays this amount to play there for the season, this charge must go up to £10 next season, this is still good value for the facilities we offer - BUT \_ The trouble is the people who pay their duesdo not like subsidising those who use the premises and don't pay & who can blame them (shades of poll tax) We believe that if everybody who play and practices there now pays thier dues we would break even. We want the premises used they are there 24 hrs a day 7 days a week & nothing pleases me more than seeing it used.

PLEASE PLAY FAIR AND HELP US ALL TO KEEP THIS VENUE FOR THE GOOD OF TABLE TENNIS ON THE WIRRAL.

#### GLUE

The rightful banning of glue by both the ITTF and ETTA which was then very quickly endorsed by our own league mamagement committee I am very pleased to say. It has been proven for a long time that solvents are a health risk.

The advantage of using speed glue is lost after aprox four hours (also proven) so there is not much point in using speed glue more than 24hrs

prior to any event you may take part in. This in short, answers any questions like the number that have already been asked of me, in effect speed glue is banned from table tennis, what you wish to do in the privacy of your own home, and if you are prepared to damage your own health providing it is at least 24hrs before your match, then that is for you to decide.

Can I also point out this also applies to coaching sessions, and that coaches/organisers should not allow it to take place.

### COUNTY WEEKENDS

This season has seen Cheshire junior 2nd team travel on two weekends to the new table tennis centre at Grantham staying overnight Fri and playing 4 matches Saturday. For one reason or another Ches 2 has had to play below strength due to this system, which has led to a number of Wirrals 11 year old players making their debut, and while I was pleasantly pleased at the way they played, it was a little early to have played for your County.
