1ST TEAM

The expectations for the season were much lower than last year as we had lost Mark Newns and Keith Gillison through age. We were lucky to face a weakened Halton Side in the first match and recorded a 7-3 victory. It was then a couple of heavy defeats 9-1 by both Barrow and St Helens that plummeted us towards the bottom of the table. The crunch relegation battle followed against Bolton and after leading 4-3 we fell apart completely to give Bolton their first win of the season 6-4. A battling display against Oldham in the last game where we lost 7-3 means we are relying on other results to be in our favour to avoid the drop. The Major reasons were the lack of a 1st Division Standard Number 3 and Peter Walsh being unable to produce his best form when it was really needed.

2ND TEAM

A mixed season with 3 wins and 4 defeats earning a mid-table place. There were 9 players used over the season, and all players getting their debuts at this level have benefitted from the experience. The most promising performances came from Chris Dunne, Alice Howard and Jeff Harris, this despite their tender years and in experience guided us to our respective wins over Salford & Farnworth, Southport and Oldham "A".
