The expectations for the season were much lower than last year as we had lost Mark Newns and Keith Gillison through age. We were lucky to face a weakened Halton Side in the first match and recorded a 7-3 victory. It was then a couple of heavy defeats 9-1 by both Barrow and St Helens that plummeted us towards the bottom of the table. The crunch relegation battle followed against Bolton and after leading 4-3 we fell apart completly to give Bolton their first win of the season 6-4. A batling display against Oldham in the last game where we lost 7-3 means we are relying on other results to be in our favour to avoid the drop. The Major reasons were the lack of a Ist Division Standard Number 3 and Peter Walsh being unable to produce his best form when it was really needed.

2ND TEAM

A mixed season with 3 wins and 4 defeats earning a mid-table place. There were 9 players used over the season, and all players getting their debuts at this level have benefitted from the experience.
