Guidance notes

- 1.Enter players names ABC for the home team and XYZ for the away team. Each player to keep the same letter throughout the match.
- 2.Each set consists of four games starting 0-0 and played up to 11 i.e. if the score reaches 10-10 you just play one more point. Enter the points scored in the first game in column 1 under the appropriate team, and second, third and fourth games in columns 2, 3, and 4.
- 3.Refer to handicap conversion chart and enter in column 5 the handicap points, if any, received by either the home or away team player.
- 4.Add the point scores in columns 1-5 and enter in column 6.
- 5.At the end of the match total up column 6 together with the 3.5 points for the away team. In the case of two teams who normally play at the same venue the away team is awarded 0.5 not 3.5 points. The team with the higher amount of points is the winner.
- 6.If a team only has two players walkovers are entered in column 6 as offenders 0 , opponents 24.
- 7.Column 7 is used to keep a running total of the score.
