There were a few issues I'd like to bring to everyone's attention (but with a focus on the team secretaries), with a hope that we'll be able to minimise problems in the next season:

Scorecards – I often receive cards that are hard to read due to 'stylised' handwriting, poor images (from photos), or incorrect scores. Please consider the Match Secretary when filling out or sending the scorecards, as I hadmore than 200 to deal with across all competitions this year, and likely more next year; every one I have to follow up on gives me less time to walk the dog.. ©Also if you can submit them in a timely fashion I'd appreciate it.

Completion of fixtures – the season runs right up until the end of April, and there are usually lots of opportunities to postpone and reorganise fixtures but you have to be proactive in doing this and don't allow them to pile up to the end of the season. Some fixtures at the end of the season were regretted, and it would be fairer for everyone if we didn't get into that situation.

Understanding Cup matches – we run 2 different but similar cup competitions; make sure you know which one you're playing in and apply the correct rules accordingly. The rules and fixture information are repeatedly shared across the season, so lack of awareness is certainly not an issue!
