Rules: 2 games per set only. Each game must start at 0 - 0. 5 serves each in turn. First to 21 points wins the game - no deuces to be played. Add handicap difference at end of game then the highest total points wins and is awarded 1 point. For games that are level when the handicap points are taken into account then each player shall be awarded ½ point.

In the event of a tie, player C will play Player Z over 2 games (21 up) and the handicap will be added to ascertain the winning team. If the scores are still equal one additional tie breaking point shall be played by the above players.

HANDICAP POINTS DIFFERENCE CALCULATION

In singles, subtract the lower handicap from the higher handicap and look up the result from the table below to find the handicap points difference.

In doubles, for each pair of players add their handicaps together then subtract one total from the other and divide the result by 2. Look up the result in the table below to find the handicap points difference for the respective pairings.
