2: The entry fee for seniors is fixed at £5 regardless of number of events entered. U21s are free of charge (born after 1st January 1997).

5: Scheduling of events subject to change based on entry numbers. Event formats may be group or straight KO based upon entry numbers		
6: Players may enter a maximum of two events on any given night to avoid fixture congestion.		
7: Junior qualification rounds are being played on 17th April 2018 and will be publicised seperately.		
8: All correspondence will be via email where possible. Please provide an SAE if you do not provide an email address.		
9: Closing date for entries is Friday 30th March 2018.		
10: Junior qualification events will be held seperately, with a combined finals' night.		
11: To enter over-60s singles players should have been born before 18th April 1958		
12: To enter over-70s singles players should have been born before 18th April 1948		
13: Premier restricted singles is open to players who have played at least 33% of matches and have a winning average of 67% or less.		
14: Events not listed in the finals night schedule will be played to a conclusion on the night. Finals night will be Tuesday 1st May 2018.		
15: Handicap singles will be short format, with 3 games to 11 points, using the official handicap cup handicaps (halved for the shorter matches.)
