

GALLEYWOOD TABLE TENNIS CLUB

(For all members and Team opponents for Autumn 2020 matches)

Players only will be admitted to the Scout Hut – and Arthur Clark when required with TT equipment.

In the event that there are scouts in the hut on arrival no-one is permitted to enter till they have left

You will be asked to confirm that you have no symptoms of Covid-19, and have not been in recent contact with any person who has recently had the Covid-19 virus. If so entry will not be permitted.

All Players will be expected to bring their own anti-bacterial gel and to sanitise their hands upon entry

Facemasks must be worn inside the venue when not playing.

Contact details are to be provided by all players for track and trace purposes.

If the Scouts were able to recommence their Monday evening activities the start of Table Tennis matches would have to put back to 8.00pm. Arthur Clark would contact the opposition opponents accordingly.

Galleywood players will be seated on the south side of the Scout Hut and the opponents on the north side for the duration of the match. Players shall be seated in the same seat when not playing.

Players shall maintain social distancing of 2m even when not playing

If wind allows then the main and/or emergency exit doors should be left open

The emergency exit must be unbolted for the duration of the match.

Facemasks can be removed for match-play or umpiring.

Match-play is nine Singles matches and no Doubles matches.

The away team player has the choice of ends at the start of his match play. There is no changing of ends at the end of each set. Each player should sanitise their hands at the end of each set

Match balls will be sanitised before play commences and at the end of each set.

No hand-wiping on the table or rubbing the ball.

No handshakes or “high fives”.

No refreshments will be provided by the home team. Players must bring their own refreshments for the evening if they require any. Use of the kitchen will not be permitted. Galleywood players may enter the kitchen to get the table tennis net and the operator units to operate the fan heaters in very cold weather.

Anti-bac hand gel will exceptionally be provided for players to use between individual matches if a player inadvertently forgets their own,

Ladies and Gents toilets at the east end of the Scout Hut may be used with one player only using the facilities. Players should use their own towels

Only the Galleywood players are to collect and return the table tennis table, the chairs and folding tables to use for umpires.

Set-up and set down and associated sanitisation will be performed by specific authorised Galleywood players only.

All personal waste must be removed from the venue by each player.

The Home Team shall forward the completed scorecard to Gordon Gatheral within 24 hours.

Any player who develops Covid-19 symptoms after playing must inform Dave Porter and Gordon Gatheral and take a Covid test immediately and provide the outcome to Dave and Gordon.

Additional requirements for Galleywood Players

Table tennis tables to be sprayed with anti-bacterial spray at the end of the evening and cleaned with a cloth

Table tennis net to be sprayed with anti-bacterial spray and wiped clean with a cloth

All doors and handles and cords holding the doors open are to be cleaned with anti-bacterial spray and or cloth at the end of the evening

Kitchen cupboard to be cleaned with anti-bacterial spray and cloth

Urinals to be sprayed with anti-bacterial spray and all taps

Toilet seat and pan to be cleaned with anti-bacterial spray

All chairs and tables used to be sprayed with anti-bacterial spray and wiped with a cloth before being put away
