

DETAILS OF PLAYERS APPEARING THIS EVENING

Kevin Read (Writtle TTC) In his early years, Kevin won local league and county titles in Singles, Doubles and team events in Kent, Bedfordshire and Buckinghamshire. He then gave up table tennis for a number of years before starting again in Essex. A former Men's Singles winner in the Burnham, Brentwood, Basildon and Southend Leagues, with a range of Doubles and team titles to his name, Kevin has represented his county as a Junior, Senior, and more recently in the Veterans first team for Essex. His last appearance at Finals Night was last year when he was beaten in the semi-final by eventual winner, Keith Adams.

Mark Mulley (Old Chelmsfordians TTC) - Mark started playing table tennis at the age 10 and went on to become an Essex Junior Champion, the top ranked player in London and as high as 26th in England as a junior as well as representing Essex as a junior. After reaching 105th in the England Men's senior rankings Mark stopped playing at age 23 because of injury. A couple of years ago he resumed playing and as well as playing in the British Senior League was an integral part of the OCA A team that won the Division 1 title of the Chelmsford League last season, along with his brother, Matthew.

Matthew Mulley (Old Chelmsfordians TTC) - Matthew is a former National Junior U18s doubles finalist and former Essex no.3 ranked junior. Reached No.26 in the England Junior rankings. Was part of the Old Chelmsfordians team that won the Chelmsford League Division 1 title last season, along with his brother Mark.

Alesha Ellis-Austin (Chelmsford TTC) – Aleesha is a former Junior Girls Champion, Handicap Doubles Champion and Under 15 Singles runner-up in Chelmsford. She was also the runner-up in the U16 event at this year's Jack Petchey London and Essex School Finals, represented

Essex in the County Championships and took part in the Junior British League.

Harry Chivers (Chelmsford TTC) Harry started playing in 2018 and as well as the being the reigning Chelmsford League Boys Singles Champion (beating Toby McLewin in the final), he also holds the Brentwood League Junior and Men's Singles Titles. He has already found success in this year's tournament with both a Hard Bat and Junior Doubles Title to his name. He is currently ranked nationally in the top 40 for his age group and competes on a regular level with some of the country's best representing Essex and Chelmsford at the likes of Senior and Junior British League and the County Junior Championships. Stop Press: Harry became the Essex Schools U19 Champion on Sunday 14 January 2024.

Harrison Hill (Chelmsford TTC) Was last year's U13s champion, but school commitments prevented him defending his title this time round. An eventful year for Harrison - he was part of a Chelmsford team to win both the National Cadet League and the National Junior League, proudly represented the Essex Cadets in the Premier Division of the County Championships, made the last 16 of the National Championships and was a member of the Chelmsford team competing in the Junior British League. In recent weeks he won an U15s tournament at BATTS, finished runner up in the C&DTTL Junior Doubles (with Evie Knaapen) and won the C&DTTL division two singles event.

<u>Duncan Taylor (Writtle TTC)</u> Vastly experienced player who was a top 10 ranked England Junior back in the day. Former Men's Singles Champion in the Basildon, Burnham, Chelmsford, and Southend Leagues. Winner of both the Men's Singles and Veterans Singles in the 2022 Burnham tournament. Vast County playing experience including playing for the Essex Veterans first team. Duncan currently plays in the Veterans British League.

<u>Paul Davison (Danbury TTC)</u> Six times Braintree Men's Singles Champion. Frequent title winner at the Chelmsford Tournament which includes successes in the Men's Doubles and Mixed Doubles as well as Semi-Final appearances in the Men's Singles. Current Braintree Men's Singles Champion taking a record 7th title last season. Also, the current Braintree Veterans Champion. Plays in the Veterans British League having also played in the Senior British League and has played County table tennis for both Essex and Suffolk.

Evie Knaapen (Buttsbury TTC) - Evie first started playing table tennis at junior school with Sidney Dorn. She has been playing in the Southend League for a couple of years, initially for Ashingdon, but due to lack of players, joined Hullbridge/Matchpoint being coached by Liam Squirrell. This season she also joined the Chelmsford League and has really enjoyed playing for Buttsbury A. In June 2023, Evie became U13 National Doubles Champion alongside her partner, and has joined with her to play in the Junior British League. Evie is currently part of the Essex County cadet team, and a reserve for both the junior and senior teams. Evie enjoys competing in lots of different competitions and is looking forward to the upcoming Jack Petchey Competition.

James Donald (Danbury TTC) James is 16 years old and currently plays for both Danbury and Tollgate and trains at BATTS with Adam Nutland. James plays for BATTS in both the Senior and Junior British Leagues and is currently ranked 32 nationally in U17s. James has played for Essex Junior and Cadet first teams, both teams are currently in their Premier divisions. In 2022 James won gold medal at the National Inter-Regionals representing East of England in the U15s event and silver medal last season in the Jack Petchey U16's event. This will be James's inaugural Chelmsford Finals Night appearance.
