


Danbury Table Tennis Club [DTTC]



COVID-19 Protocols

[for all members and visitors]

Pre-Entry to Danbury Village Hall

Players only will be admitted to the venue – no spectators/guests.

You will be asked to confirm you have no symptoms of Covid 19, and have not been in recent contact with anyone who has the Covid-19 virus – else entry will not be permitted.

You will be temperature checked – anyone unwilling to be tested or with a temperature outside the normal range will not be permitted entry into the venue.

You will be asked to sanitise your hands with your own, or provided, anti-bacterial gel.

Facemasks must be worn inside the Venue.

Contact details are to be provided by all players for track & trace purposes.

Match Set-up

Every player will be provided a seat which will be for their sole use for the duration of the match.

Players will maintain social distancing of 2m or 1m+, even when not playing.

Facemasks can be removed for match-play or umpiring.

Windows will be left open for ventilation.

Maximum set-up of 2 tables for senior matches.

Match Play

No Doubles.

Match Balls will be sanitised before play commences.

No hand-wiping on tables.

No blowing or rubbing the ball.

No changing ends – away team has choice of ends at start of play.

No Handshakes or 'high-fives'.

No refreshments, incl tap water, will be provided – players must bring ample refreshments for the evening.

Anti-bac hand gel will be provided for players to use between individual matches.

General Hygiene

Only the Disabled toilets are to be used – prior to each match you will be informed of route to use.

On completion of session you will be guided to best exit to use.

Access to communal spaces (eg. kitchen and storage) strictly limited and off limits for players except those designated to collect equipment.

Set-up and set down and associated sanitisation will be performed by specific authorised DTTC members only.

All personal waste must be removed from the venue by each player.

The Club has a Covid cleaning kit available in the storage units.

Post-Match

Any player who develops Covid-19 symptoms after playing at the Danbury venue must inform DTTC and take a Covid test immediately and provide DTTC with the outcome.
