Covid-19 Rules

For all members and visiting players

Pre-Entry to Hatfield Village Hall

Players only will be admitted to the venue. No spectators or guests will be permitted entry. Players will be asked to confirm that they have no symptoms of Covid-19. Players will be asked to confirm that they have not been in recent contact with anyone who has the Covid-19 virus. Entry will not be permitted if any player answers yes to either of these statements. Players will be asked to sanitise their hands with their own or provided anti-bacterial gel. Facemasks must be worn inside the venue when not playing or umpiring. Contact details are to be provided by all players for track and trace purposes.

Match Set-up

Entry to the Hall will be via the car park entrance. Players must follow the arrows into the Hall where they will be guided to their match table. Every player will be provided with a seat which will be for their sole use for the duration of the match. Players will maintain social distancing of 2m or 1m+, even when not playing. Windows will be left open for ventilation. Maximum set-up of 3 tables for senior matches.

Match Play

No Doubles. Match balls will be sanitised before play commences. No hand-wiping on tables. No blowing or rubbing the ball. No changing ends. The away team has the choice of ends at the start of play. No handshakes or 'high-fives'. No refreshments including tap water will be provided. Players should bring their own refreshments for the evening. Anti-bacterial hand gel will be provided for players to use between individual matches.

General Hygiene

Players will be informed of route to access the toilets. On completion of the session, players will be guided to the most appropriate exit. Access to communal spaces e.g. kitchen and storage will be strictly limited. Set-up / set down / associated sanitisation will be performed by specific authorised HPTTC members only. All personal waste must be removed from the venue by each player. The HPTTC Club will have a Covid-19 cleaning kit available.

Post-Match: Any player who develops Covid-19 symptoms after playing at the Hatfield Peverel venue must inform HPTTC and follow government guidelines.
